Received notice just before the board meeting that New York State recently passed the law that prohibits smoking on playgrounds. Governor’s approval of legislation meant to protect our state’s youth. The newly signed law (A.4205/S1643-Chapter 102 of the Laws of New York 2013) will prohibit smoking at public playgrounds where children under twelve are present during the hours between sunrise and sunset. This legislation would not prevent local municipalities from enacting or applying more rigorous anti-smoking policies.
